

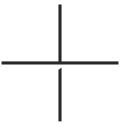

The green season creates a haven for wildlife, not only for its seasonal visitors, but also a large variety of year-round wildlife, from large herds of elephants to endangered wild dogs and big cats, with incredible sightings of leopards and lions. Soak up the solitude of the South Luangwa and enjoy the exclusivity that this secret season offers.





SOUTH LUANGWA

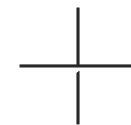
Home to the original walking safari, South Luangwa is the perfect destination for adventurous and active travellers. With our award-winning guiding team, you can explore as you please, discovering the diverse tapestry of habitats that comprise South Luangwa National Park. During the green season, with the Luangwa River flowing at its highest levels, this is the season for boating safaris. With many migrant species flocking to the river, it is an excellent time for bird watching. You'll have the unique opportunity to see the largest yellow-billed stork colony nesting in the flooded forests. It is also the best time of year to see endangered wild dogs. Year-round, you can expect iconic river crossings of large herds of elephant and epic leopard and lion sightings.



TIME + TIDE CHINZOMBO

Named after a type of tree which grows near camp, Chinzombo's award-winning design blends modern style with the best of a traditional safari camp. Each of its six spacious luxury safari tents (including a two-bedroom, two-bathroom family tent) stretch out onto a shaded verandah where you can while away the afternoon or unwind with an in-room spa treatment. Each tent has a private pool and soaking tub with panoramic views over the river and its abundant wildlife. Down a winding path, the main lodge beckons. Lounge on the riverfront sun deck with a book from the open-air library. Enjoy dinner under the stars, sip a drink at bar while browsing through old photos, or around the fire pit suspended high atop the river bank.





TIME + TIDE KAKULI

Venture deep into the heart of the South Luangwa National Park at Kakuli, meaning old buffalo bull, the nickname given by locals to Norman Carr, the pioneer of walking safaris. Its five bright and airy safari rooms (including a two-bedroom, two-bathroom family safari room) are designed to make the most of the panoramic setting. The elevated main lounge overlooks the river and a permanent lagoon. Beneath it, a wildlife hide offers up-close views of visitors stopping by for a drink. Take a deep breath and admire the sweeping vista with a refreshing drink of your own.
